In 2004, KOTWIBAKABO joined the well-established, COOPAC Kirorero, an umbrella cooperative that brings together coffee producers from the six areas of Rwanda's Western Province: Ack, Ubuzima, Tuzamurane, Kopabm, Abakundakurima and Abanyamurava.

KOTIWABAKABO is located in the Boneza sector of the Western Province overlooking the scenic Lake Kivu, one of Africa's Great Lakes. Today, KOTWIBAKABO includes 15,011 total member farmers and specializes in fully washed Bourbon heirloom coffee, a prized Arabica coffee strain. These coffees are washed at nearby Kirorero washing station in Boneza and then naturally sun dried at an elevation up to 1900 meters above sea level.

Supremo has worked tirelessly over many years with COOPAC to improve the living conditions of small producers in Rwanda, develop consistent quality, and ultimately bring their coffee to the US market.
