

ATTACHING TO GRAINFATHER



1. Position your lugs on the rear of the control box in the right place to suit your Grainfather. These are removable.



2. Feed cord through the cradle and sit the control box on the cradle. Fit the lugs at the rear into the holes on the bracket on the Grainfather.



3. Attach all plugs and temperature probe connection. Plug the cord from the pump into the pump inlet underneath the control box, do the same for the plug coming from the boiler. The plug exiting the pump is the pump plug, the plug exiting the boiler base is the heating element plug. **NOTE:** You are likely to want to lift the unit up to insert this, but remember it is best to brew with the Grainfather on the floor due to heavy lifting later on.

IMPORTANT TO NOTE:

If you have an Original Grainfather, ensure the switch on the base of the unit is always set to 'Normal'. This will leave the control box in charge of managing the heating properly.
